

Another Nursery favourite this week – Cross the River. We usually play this with our friend Crispin the crow. He sends his love and can't wait to see you all!




To play this game, you will need a selection of objects (see below) and some blue fabric (an item of clothing would do) to represent the river. The adult then says the sounds for each object like this: 'cross the river and get the c-u-p (cup)'. The child then jumps across the fabric 'river' to select the correct object. We say things like 'don't get your feet wet!' to make it more fun. Make sure you use the correct pronunciation for the letter sounds as this is really important. Have a look at this video to check if you're not sure.
