


Hello nursery children!

Story Discussion CLL, L, PSED, UW

Before reading, look at the front cover image together. Where do you think the girl could be going? What might she see?

Discuss the story together. Can you tell me what happened in the story? What did the girl see? Talk about the rhythm of the words and how they sound like the motion of a train.

Have you ever been on a train ride? Where did you go? What did you see?

Play Trains EAD, MD, PD, CL, UW, PSED, L



You could design your own small world scene for the story. Think about what could be seen through the window in the story. If you have a train set, you could use it to retell the story. Or, you could make your own train using junk modelling materials.

You could role play a train journey, from buying a ticket, to finding a seat and watching the world go by through the window. Why not make your own cardboard box train?

Use a toy train to make marks in paint, mud or food colouring. You could create your very own work of art! Look closely at the tracks the train makes. You could compare the tracks made by different wheeled toys, such as a car or a bus.


