Before reading the story, look at the picture on the front cover. What do you think the story is about?


Discuss the story together.

Cardboard Box Play EAD, MD, PD, CL, UW, PSED

Use a large cardboard box to make a house like the one in the story. You can decorate it with a door, a door number, some windows and some flowers growing around it.



You can use your box house to retell the story 'This is Our House'. Or, you could use it as a special den to read stories and play games in!
