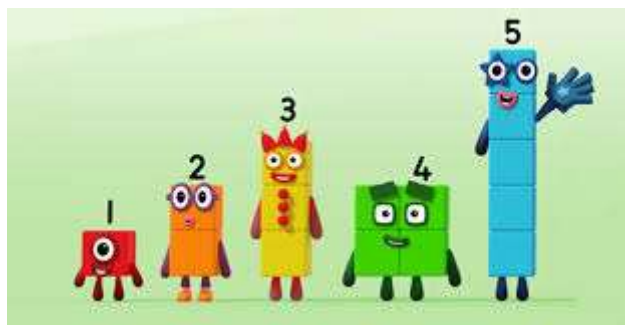


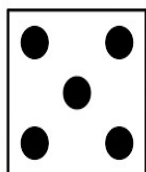
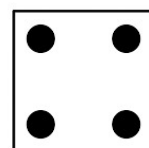
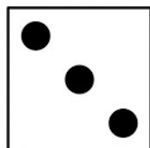
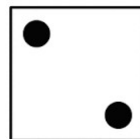
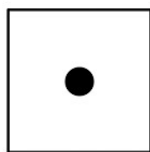
Mathematical Development
