Before reading the story, look at the picture on the front cover. What do you think the story is about?


Discuss the story together.

Rainbow Fish Collage EAD, MD, PD, CL, UW




Have a go at making your own rainbow fish using collage.

How many fish can you catch? Act out the rhyme 'Once I Caught a Fish Alive' in the water.


You could have a walk to 'Pets at Home' at Lyme Green to see some different types of fish. Which fish do you like best? Why?
