

Story Discussion CLL, L, PSED, UW

Discuss the story together.

There are lots of things going on in the park. What did you see?

Can you tell me what happened in the story?

Talk about why Timothy mistook a cat, a bird and his dad for a shark.

What did you notice at the end of the book?

What do you think might happen next?
