### Hello nursery children!



Make a Bear Cave EAD, PD, PSED, CL

# Prepositions (Positional Language) MD, CL, PD

The story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' contains lots of prepositions, which are words that tell us about the position of something (where it is). For example, 'we can't go over it, we can't go under it'.

Using a teddy and a box, you can play a game to help with the understanding of prepositions. Take it in turns to hide the teddy. Teddy could be ...

In, on, under, behind, in front of or next to the box.
