
Maths Challenge.

The Copycat Game

You will need some paper and some colouring pens or pencils

- Find or make some paper with squares on it. Make the squares quite big at first to make things easier until your child gets used to the idea.
- Fold the paper lightly down the middle and draw a dark line along the fold...



This is the line of symmetry

- Two players should choose a side each.
- Your grown up goes first and colours in one square on their side.
- You should then colour the same square on your side of the line, with the same colour. Like doubling.
- Keep taking turns. Remember your grown up chooses and you copy, or double. You are the copycat.

Can you see a symmetrical pattern? Have you made a double of your grown-up's pattern?
