

Year 4 Spellings

Week 3

Over the next few weeks we will be looking at adding the suffix -ly. All of the rules are covered on the next couple of slides. The spelling words have been split over two weeks.

Adding –ly to make adverbs.

- If the root word ends in 'y', change the 'y' to an 'i' and add 'ly'.

Happy – happily

Easy – easily

Angry - angrily

Lucky – luckily

- If the root word ends in 'le', change 'le' to 'ly'.

Gentle - gently

Simple - simply

Horrible – horribly

Adding –ly to make adverbs.

- If the root word ends with –ic, –ally is added rather than just –ly, except in the word *publicly*.

Basic – basic**ally**

Frantic – frantic**ally**

Dramatic – dramatic**ally**

- **Most other endings you just add ‘ly’**

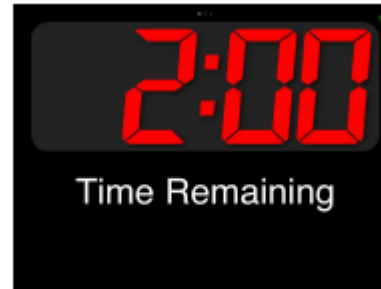
Rainbow Words
