Over the next few weeks we will be looking at adding the suffix -ly. All of the rules are covered on the next couple of slides. The spelling words have been split over two weeks.

Adding -ly to make adverbs.

• If the root word end in 'y', change the 'y' to an 'i' and add 'ly.

```
Happy – happily
Easy – easily
Angry - angrily
Lucky – luckily
```

• If the root word ends in 'le', change 'le' to 'ly'.

```
Gentle - gently
Simple - simply
Horrible – horribly
```

Adding -ly to make adverbs.

• If the root word ends with —ic, —ally is added rather than just —ly, except in the word *publicly*.

Basic – basically

Frantic – frantically

Dramatic – dramatically

Most other endings you just add 'ly'

suddenly proudly foolishly completely bravely wildly nervously
