Where is this place? What is it like? How do you know? Would you like to be there? Why or why not? Have you ever been somewhere like this? Where was it? What was it like? How might it feel to be here?


Look at the bird- Do you know what this bird is? Why might it be here? What do you think the robin might be thinking about this place?

Is this what this place should be like? Who is responsible for this place being the way it is? How do we know? What could be done to improve this place? Whose responsibility is it to improve it?

Look at the first page of the story-

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Write down things you observe I can see... Do you have any questions you want to know/find out about.

Discussion points:

How does this illustration make you feel? Why?

How would you describe this place to someone else?

What do you think it is like to be there? What can you see? What might you hear?

What might it smell like? How would it feel to be in this place?

How is the little girl feeling when in this place? How do you know?

I think the girl is sat in an<u>abandoned</u> car park.

What do you think abandoned means?

Are there any abandoned spaces in your local area?

Is a place abandoned if creatures live there?

What does abandoned look, feel, sound and smell like?

How can you describe abandoned?
