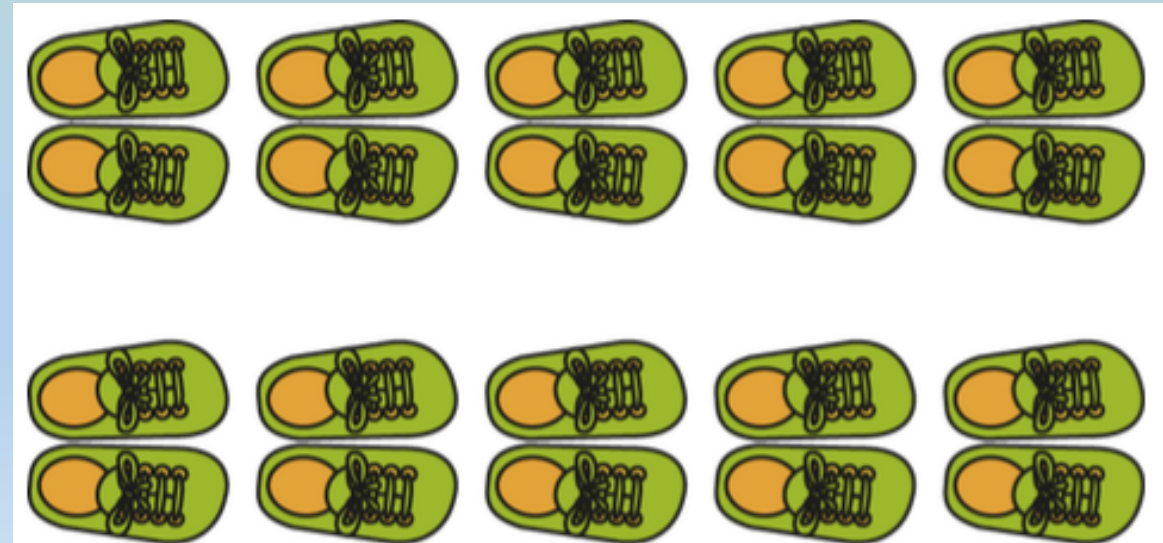


Activity 2: Question 1

How many wheels are there? Count in groups of twos.

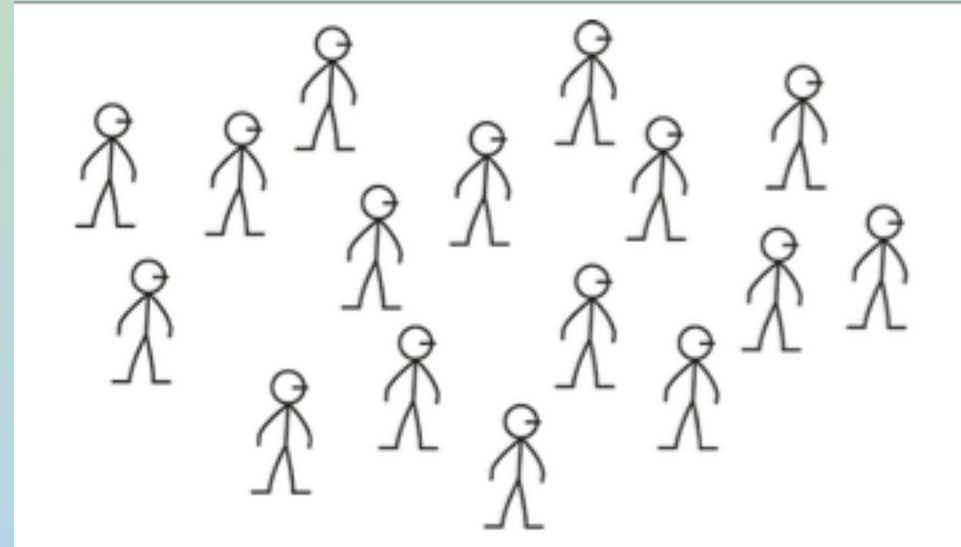


How many pairs of shoes are there? Count in groups of two.

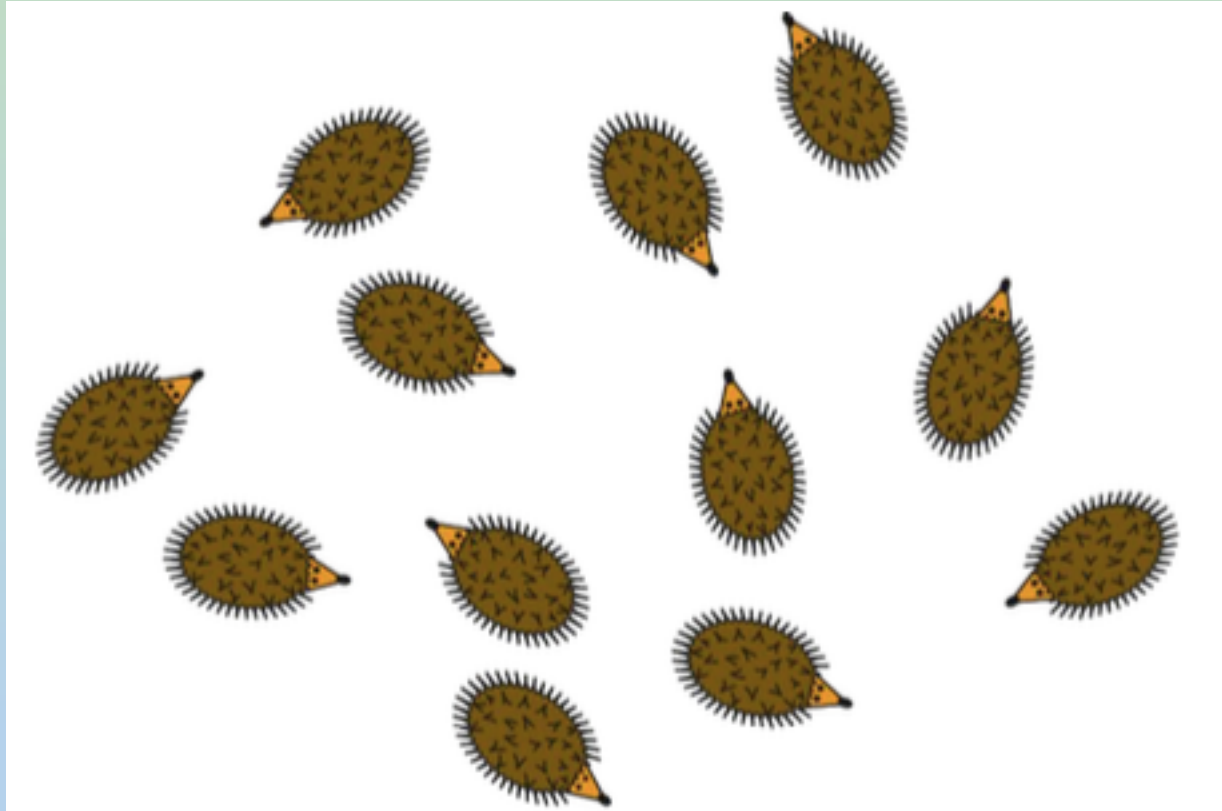


Activity 2: Question 2

(circle groups of 2)



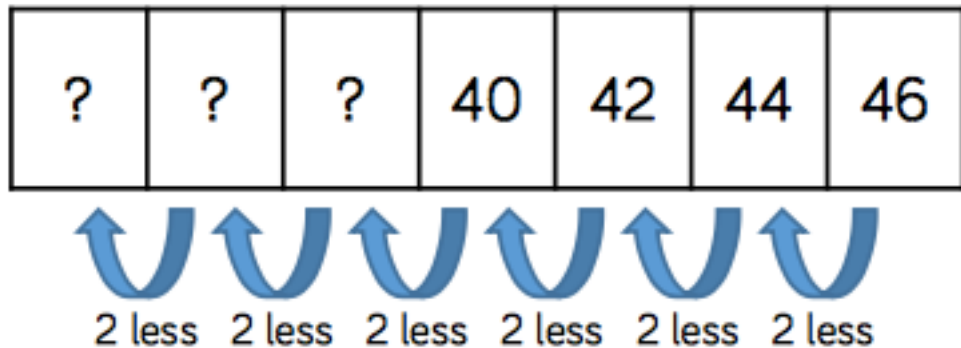
Activity 2: Question 3
