

















In summer robins care for their chicks. They keep laying eggs until July. Before a group of eggs hatches it is called a clutch, after it is called a brood. Normally the female robin lays four to six eggs at a time.

In the spring and summer robins eat worms, beetles, spiders and caterpillars.



In the autumn robins begin to live on their own. The chicks have to find their own territory and food to eat. The adults stop living in pairs.


