This week, we are learning about the suffix $-\mathbf{ful}$

A suffix is a group of letters we can join onto the end of a word to change it into a new word.

We can change a noun (thing) into an adjective (describing word) by adding the suffix -ful.

Something which is beautiful is full of beauty. Something which is painful is full of pain.


Example:

Pain + ful = painful

After I fell off my bike, I had a painful cut on my knee.
