Activity 2

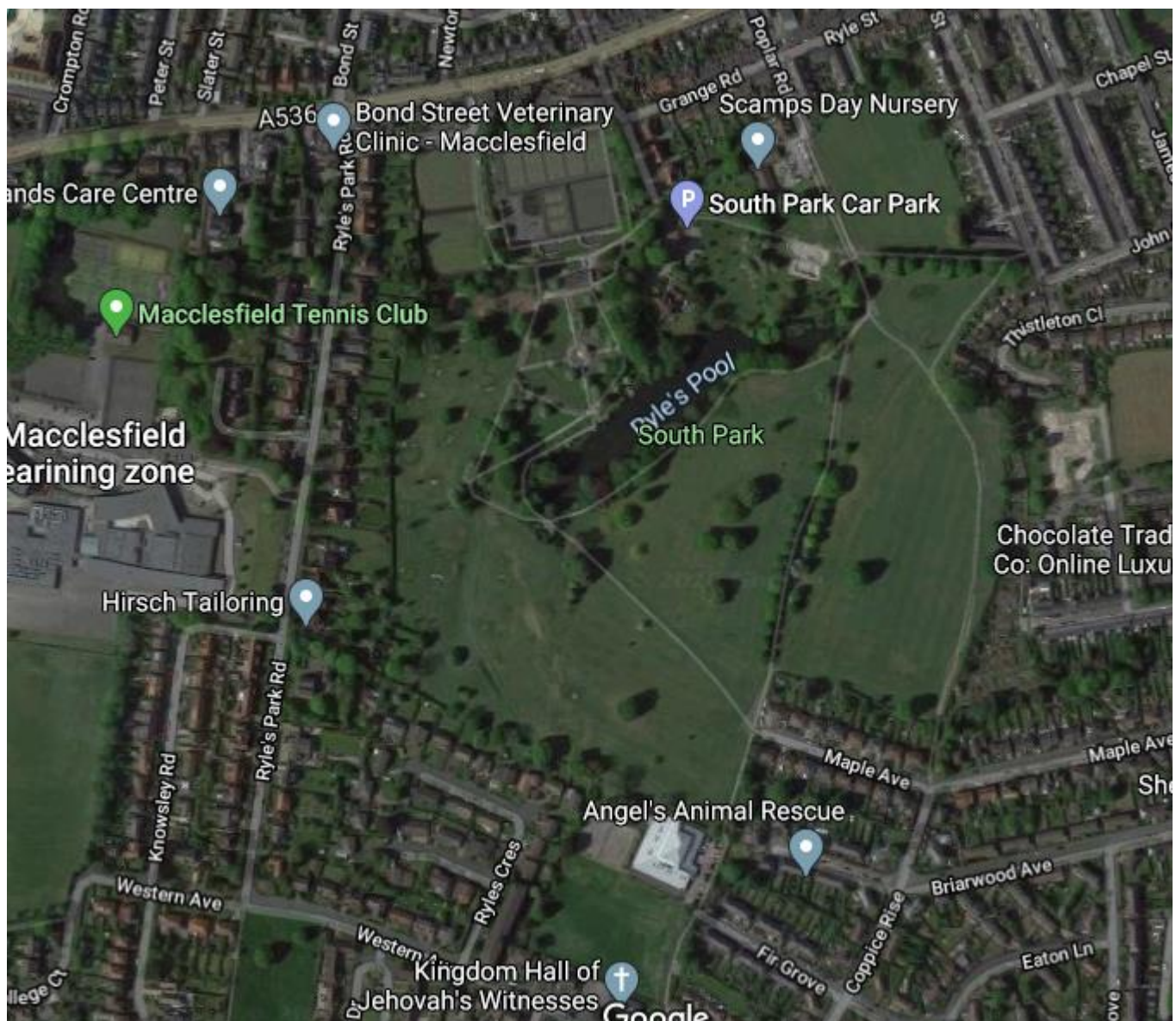
Have a look at the picture below.

Can you spot the geographical features from Activity 1? You will have to look very carefully.



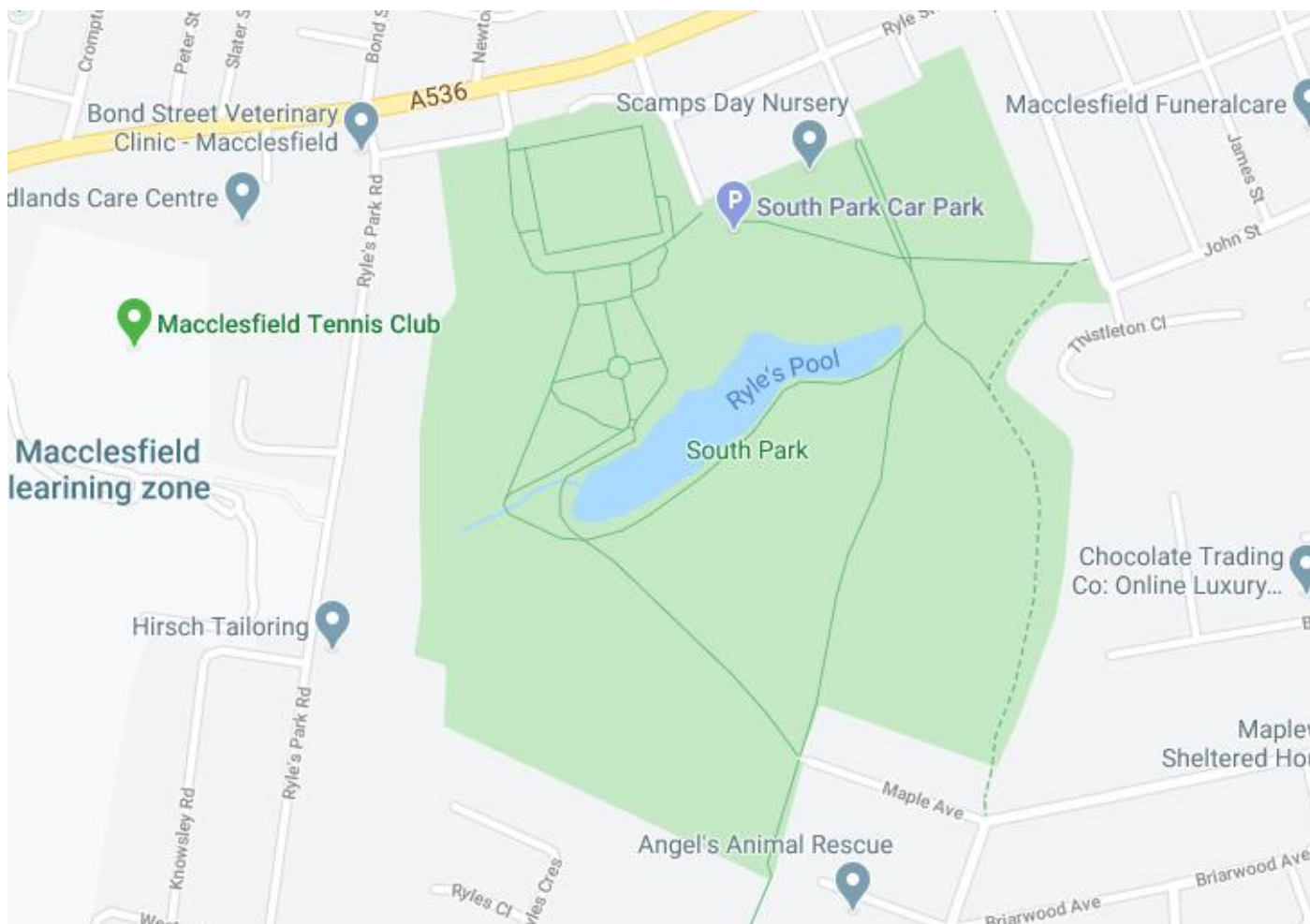
Below is a map showing the same place.
