## History – Queen Victoria

This half term in history, we are learning about global history, which means the history of the world. Queen Victoria was an important person in world history and together we are going to find out why.

### Activity 1:

Look at this picture of Queen Victoria.



In your book, write down 5 questions about the picture.

Remember to use question words to start your question, such as why, how, when, where, what

My example: **When was queen Victoria alive?**

### Activity 2:

On the next page there 8 events from Queen Victoria's life, but they are in the wrong order! Put them in order from the first event to the last event by putting a number next to each one. Look carefully at the dates to do this. If you can't print out the sheet, write the events out in your book next to the numbers 1-8. I've done number 1 as an example.

	<p><b>1837</b> William IV dies; Victoria becomes Queen.</p>	
	<p><b>1897</b> Diamond jubilee (celebration for 60 years as Queen).</p>	
	<p><b>1819</b> Princess Victoria is born.</p>	<p>1</p>
	<p><b>1861</b> Albert dies (Victoria wears black for the rest of her life!)</p>	
	<p><b>1901</b> Queen Victoria dies.</p>	
	<p><b>1840-1857</b> 9 children are born!!</p>	
	<p><b>1887</b> Golden Jubilee (celebration for 50 years as Queen)</p>	
	<p><b>1840</b> Victoria marries her cousin, Prince Albert.</p>
