Activity 1

Watch the first part of the video then answer the questions below:

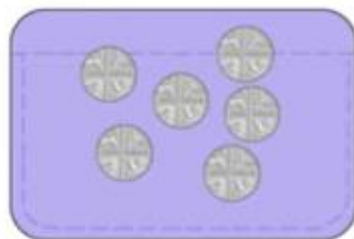
1. Miss Coope says the value of the coins in purse B is higher because there are more coins. Is she right or wrong? Explain your answer.



She is wrong because in purse A the value is $6 \times 5p = 30p$. In purse B the value is $10 \times 2p = 20p$. So the value of the coins in purse A is higher.

2. Label each purse with the correct value of the coins inside:

5p purse
30p



1p purse
9p



10p purse
90p



3. Draw 4 purses like the ones below and then draw coins in each purse so that the value in each purse is 10p.



1p purse – 10 x 1p, 2p purse – 5 x 2p, 5p purse – 2 x 5p, 10p purse – 1 x 10p

Activity 2

Watch the second part of the video then answer the questions below:



1. What could you buy from the shop above with the coins in this purse? List all the things. Can you buy 2 things? Can you buy 3 things?

There is 90p in the purse so you could buy the dinosaur for 90p or the aeroplane and the boat for 75p or the boat and the drum and the teddy for 57p. You can buy any combination as long as they add up to 90p or less.



2. What could you buy from the shop above with the coins in this purse?



The coins in the purse add up to 30p. You could buy a boat for 30p or a drum and a teddy for 27p.
