This week, we are learning about the suffix -less

A suffix is a group of letters we can join onto the end of a word to change it into a new word.

We can change a noun (thing) into an adjective (describing word) by adding the suffix -less.

The suffix -less means without:

Something which is hopeless is without hope. Something which is painless is without pain.


Example:

Pain + less = painless.

I thought having a filling was going to hurt but in fact it was painless.
