Don't forget Joe Wicks PE and Jumpstart Jonny to give your brain a break and get your heart pumping. I hope you are managing to get outside lots too.

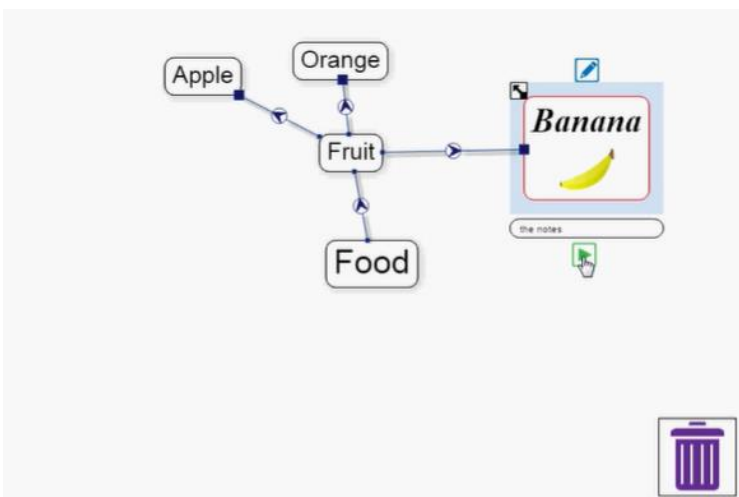

### Computing

We are using a programme called 2Connect to present our ideas using a mind map. A mind map connects ideas like this:



Log into Purple Mash and click on the red 2Dos button then select 2Connect.

Everyone should have a Purple Mash log in, but if you have any problems logging in, let me know.

Click in the top right of the screen on the



icon to watch a video with an explanation of how to use the programme.

I would like you to use the 2Connect programme to design your own mind map to show your learning about different types of **living things** from our science.

You will need to start with 'living things' in the middle and then use arrows to point to 'animals' and 'plants' then more arrows to show different types of animals and plants. You can add as much information as you like and you can even use pictures.

Save your work on Purple Mash with your name then I can see and what you have come up with. You can add a message for me when you save it if you like!
