1. Label each coin with its value then say how much money there is altogether:



1p 2p 5p 10p = 18p

There are 4 2p coins.

The coins have a value of 8 p altogether.

3. Draw a set of 2p coins to make a total value of 10p.



4. Miss Coope says she has 14p. Is she right or wrong? Explain your answer.



She is wrong because she has $2 \times 2p + 10p + 1p = 15p$

There are 5 5p coins.

The total value is 25 p.

What did you count in to help you work this out?

I counted in 5s because they are all 5p coins.

2. Draw a set of 5p coins with a total value of 40p.



3.

There are 5 10p coins.

The total value is 50 p.

4. I have six ten pence coins. What is the total value of this set of coins?

$$6 \times 10p = 60p$$

5. Miss Coope has ten 5p coins. Mrs Dunning has five 10p coins. Who has the most money? Explain your answer.

They both have the same amount of money because $5 \times 10 = 10 \times 5$

They both have 50p.
