



Year 6 Home Learning – Week 6

Here is the plan for this week. You can complete the tasks in any order and organise your time as you and your grown-ups feel is best.

- **Reading** – Reading every day for at least 20 minutes. If you would like to, you could choose an activity from the reading grid to complete once you have finished. Complete a 'test' from your reading SATs buster book at least twice a week.
- **Spelling** – Continue to practise the words from 3/4 and 5/6 spelling lists which you took home in your home learning packs. There are 10 words to focus on this week from the 3/4 and 5/6 spelling lists. Once you have nailed them, you can cross them off the list! You can practise these on spelling shed or by choosing an activity from the spelling menu.
- **Maths** – Complete at least one arithmetic challenge and one 'test' from your SATs buster book. Complete the two maths activities I have uploaded. Get on TTRS and challenge each other (and me)!
- **Writing** – Complete at least one SPaG test from your SATs buster book this week. Complete the two literacy tasks I have uploaded. Don't forget, you can write about anything at any time if you are feeling inspired!
- **Computing** – We are going to look at 'Text Adventures' this half term. I have uploaded the instructions for the whole scheme of work but I only want you to complete lesson 1 and 2 this week. All the resources you need have been set as 2dos.
- **Music** – I have uploaded the link to the Love Music Trust Key Stage 2 lessons. You can work through just one or all of the lessons, however you like. I think this would be a really good activity to do with other people at home, especially if you have siblings who are also in Key Stage 2!
